Since her husband's death, Kelly has endured many setbacks including a burglary on her house and an automobile accident. Kelly cleans houses for a living, so she relies heavily on her car in order to travel from home to home to clean them. So being left without her car has caused even more stress.

At times Kelly has felt helpless and hopeless as she works to keep her family intact and together. She has a huge heart and is constantly doing things for other people in her life. Kelly's dear friend Paulette Bopp nominated her as a H.O.W.

recipient at last month's H.O.W. dinner because she knows Kelly is an incredibly deserving woman who desperately needs a financial boost. But Paulette also wants Kelly to know there are so many women who have a heartfelt desire to help less fortunate women in their own community whether or not they know each other.
