Summer is happily married to her husband David, and they have two special-needs sons born less than two years apart. William was born with a heart defect which required surgery. He will continue to visit the cardiologist annually at least into his teen years. During the fall of the same year that William had surgery, Summer and David realized that Timothy, who had displayed incredible signs of intelligence, was autistic. William was on the mend, but he was weak and susceptible to illness. Summer had to be careful of William's exposure while also trying to work with Timothy to strengthen his deficiencies. To this day, Timothy has weak core strength, problems with sensory integration, poor eye contact, "sing-song" voice, hyper attention span (with certain activities) fine motor delay, and problems with social interaction, amongst other issues. Summer works with Timothy daily which takes unbelievable patience. David says, "Summer is the catalyst that keeps our home going. She has done an amazing job with our family. While she is not perfect, she is wonderful as a mother and wife for which Timothy, William, and I are forever grateful."
