DeeDee Bingham lives in Lemoore where she has been employed at Lemoore High School for many years. She is a breast cancer survivor. As of March 15, 2010, she has been cancer free for 5 years. Three years ago her husband, Tom, was diagnosed with melanoma and had over 30 lymph nodes removed, some of them cancerous. He was cancer free for one year and then he was diagnosed with colon cancer and had colostomy surgery. They also found a spot in his liver which turned out to be cancerous too and he has been going through research protocol treatment at Stanford University. They travel there every three weeks. DeeDee continues to work at LHS and is Tom's primary caregiver.
